## **Player Rating Instructions**

**Coaches are required to email this form (as an Excel doc) to their division coordinator prior to October 12, 2007.**

Rate your players only against players in the same division. Each player will be rated 1 – 5 for each of the categories listed (there will be no zero). The points will be added together for a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 25 points per player.

### **Passing/Shooting**

A 5 would be a player that can use both of their feet to shoot the ball with power and control, and pass with good speed and accuracy. A 1 would be a player that has trouble passing or shooting the ball with accuracy and power.

### **Dribbling**

A 5 would be a player that can dribble up the field, around defenders, and control the ball with both feet while looking up. A 1 would be a player that loses control of the ball while moving around the field.

### **Defense**

A 5 would be a player that understands how to take a ball cleanly away from his/her opponent. A 1 would be a player that struggles with getting the ball from an opponent.

### **Speed / Stamina**

A 5 would be a player who shows great speed and has the ability to play effectively at a sustained pace for the entire game. A 1 would be a player that has trouble keeping up with the game and other players around the field.

### **Interest / Knowledge of the Game**

A 5 would be a player who understands the rules, concepts, and strategies of the game (a play maker). A 1 would be a player that struggles to understand the concepts of soccer and various parts of the game.
